

Environmental Compliance

This Certificate of Compliance applies to products or series, manufactured by American Zettler, Zettler Controls and Zettler Magnetics, where to the best of our knowledge and unless otherwise specified are in compliance with the following:

- RoHS Directive 2015/863/EU and RoHS 2 Directive 2011/65/EU restricting the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment and do not contain any of the regulated substances in concentrations greater than the listed maximum value.
 - *Exemptions: These are certain applications where EU RoHS Restricted substances may be used. In this case, if Cadmium Oxide is used, exemption by amendment 8(b)-I "for use with electrical contacts" only applies and the item is considered RoHS compliant using an exemption.
- **REACH** Regulation **(EC) No. 1907/2006** of the European Parliament and of the Council of **18 December 2006** concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals. No chemicals found on the latest Substances of Very High Concern list **(SVHC-223)** are present above the 0.1% (weight/weight) threshold.
- The U.S. **EPA** Environmental Protection Agency concerning 6 chemicals, in concentrations lower than the listed maximum value, under Section 6(h) of the Toxic Chemicals under the Toxic Substances Control Act (**TSCA**) that are persistent, bio-accumulative toxins (PBT's) effective on **March 8, 2021**.
- California Proposition 65 The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 intended to protect the U.S. State of California's citizens and drinking water sources regarding the exposure to specific chemicals which the state of California's risk assessment process has determined to present a risk of cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.

Be assured, Zettler will continue to monitor the above regulations, compare any newly listed chemicals with the raw materials in finished products and communicate the information accordingly. In addition, this declaration of conformity is issued under the sole responsibility of Zettler Group. We would like to point out expressly that it is the customer's responsibility to pay attention to any possible exceptions and their validity.
