The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 is intended to protect the U.S. State of California's citizens and the State's drinking water sources as well as inform citizens about exposure to some specific chemicals. This Act, commonly known as Proposition 65 (Prop 65), establishes a list of chemicals which the state of California's risk assessment process has determined to present a risk of cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.
